The high water shown on the lower cross-sections was occasioned by back water from the Red River, to which stream the flooding was due. It has been assumed for the purposes of this report that the level of water in the upper level for water power will be maintained at an elevation of 90.00. The power to be obtained will therefore depend upon the difference between 90.00 and the elevation of water in the lower reach, which for the past season, at cross-section No. 17, it will be seen has varied from 64.8, ice level, during February and March, to 79.3 on the 26th April. The rise on the 26th April was only temporary and was caused by ice jams in the river. The highest water due to the normal flow of the river occurred on 3rd May and was 71.00, and...
