We cannot speak with certainty upon these and many other points, but perhaps the most important step toward clearing them up will have been taken when a number of investigators have carefully worked over the data afforded by school marks. For some purposes it may be satisfactory to gather the grades of a large number of pupils as they may rank in a single year, or semester. However, for more exact results it would certainly be...
