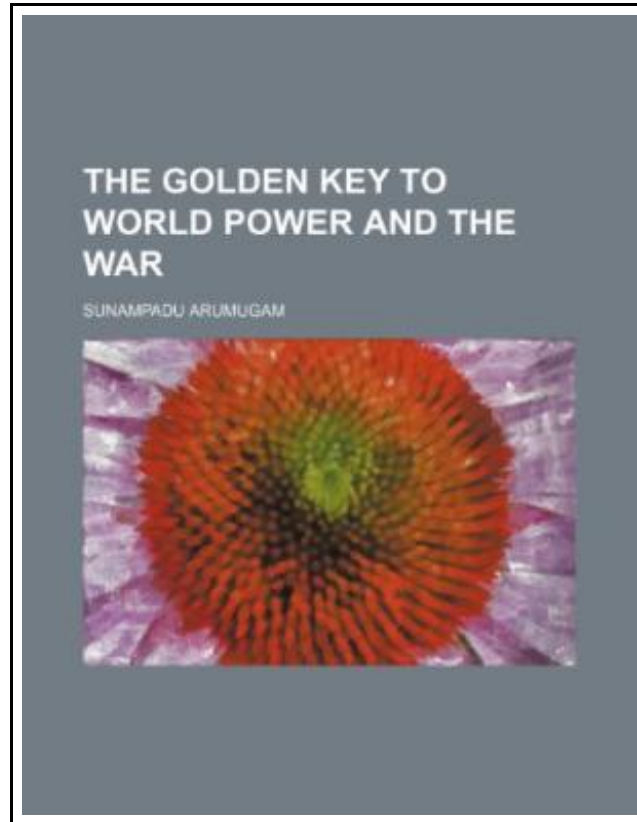

Excerpt: . . . CHAPTER III. RISE AND FALL OF PORTUGUESE POWER IN INDIA. Before the last quarter of the 15th century India was to the Christian nations of the West a closed country. The whole of the carrying trade, both to the East and to the West, for centuries was in the hands of the Mohammedans. They benefited by the monopoly of it. Through the gates of the mouth of the Red Sea, and the mouth of the Persian Gulf the wealth of India poured into the marts of Arabia and Persia. After Spain and Portugal freed themselves from the Mohammedan power they were set at liberty to work out their own salvation. After a century of strenuous efforts a sea route was discovered to the East when Bartholomew Dias rounded the Cape of Good Hope in 1487. The Portuguese were not slow in taking advantage of this discovery. They despatched three vessels under Vasco da Gama, on July 8th, 1497, which reached India, some eight miles north of Calicut, on May 17th, 1498. The condition of Malabar, and the state of the civilisation of Calicut, under Samuri, at this period can be well ascertained from the testimony of a Persian, Abdur Razak, who visited Calicut in 1442, 56 years before Vasco da Gama landed there. In spite of his dislike to the Malabar Coast and the cold treatment he received from Samuri of Calicut, the chief ruler of Malabar, his description of it is noteworthy. The...
